

# RESOLUTION R218-11/12

*To Award the Contract on the Memorial Avenue Drainage Project*

**WHEREAS**, the City of Selma accepted bids during the month of July 2012 for a proposal on the Memorial Avenue Drainage Project; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 26, 2012, the City Council approved a budget for the project in the amount of \$50,600.00 including engineering costs for Hogg Engineering Corporation in the amount of \$6,600.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the Selma City Schools Superintendent Gerald Shirley previously agreed to split the cost of all expenses and repairs with the City of Selma; and

**WHEREAS**, bids were opened on Tuesday, July 10, 2012, and the lowest responsible bidder was Mitchell Contracting Service, LLC in the amount of \$34,372.80; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of Hogg Engineering Corporation that the contract be awarded to Mitchell Contracting Service, LLC in the amount of \$34,372.80.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:**


The contract for the Memorial Avenue Drainage Project is awarded to Mitchell Contracting Service, LLC in the amount of \$34,372.80; and

The City of Selma is hereby ordered to forward a signed copy of said resolution to Mitchell Contracting Service, LLC notifying the same of the City of Selma's acceptance and approval of the bid and is hereby awarded the contract for the proposed sewer cave-in in the amount of \$34,372.80 and to Hogg Engineering for Professional and Engineering Inspection fees in the amount of \$6,600.00.

Be it further resolved that the City of Selma hereby approves and shall be responsible for half of all expenses in the amount of \$20, 486.00 and the Selma City Schools shall be responsible for the remainder of \$20,486.00.

George Patrick Evans, in his official capacity as Mayor, is hereby directed to proceed with the execution of the contract awarded to Mitchell Contracting Service, LLC and to notify the Selma City Schools.


