

RESOLUTION

R 200 – 06/07

WHEREAS, the City of Selma desires to apply to United States Department of Agriculture/Rural Development for a FY 2007 – 2008 grant for The Housing Preservation Grant (HPG) program which provides grants to sponsoring organizations for the repair or rehabilitation of low- and very low-income housing; and

WHEREAS, the City of Selma possesses the legal authority to apply for said grant and execute the proposed program; and


WHEREAS, the application will be reviewed and grants awarded to localities rating the highest in the rating criteria; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project is \$451,800.00.00 and the maximum grant amount is \$382,300.00; the City of Selma pledges to provide approximately 12% cash match at approximately \$50,000.00 and 4% in-kind match in the amount of approximately \$19,500.00 to be appropriated in the FY 2007 – 2008 budget.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the city hereby authorizes the filing of said application, including all understandings and assurances contained therein, and does hereby authorize and direct Mayor James Perkins, Jr. as the official representative of the applicant to act in connection with the application and to provide such information as may be required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the City of Selma pledges to provide 12 % cash match in the amount of \$50,000.00 in the FY 07-08 budget via line item Grant Matching Funds in the Planning and Development’s budget


